Instructions

Computer Science degree requirements include the selection of a set of related electives. The default rule for related electives is that a student choose courses totaling at least twelve quarter hours from one discipline. Courses at RIT have a seven-digit registration number. The first two digits identify a college and the next two digits identify a discipline. Thus, three courses that all begin with 0105, 0521, 1016, or 4002, for example, come from one discipline. Two courses that begin with 0105 and one course that begins with 0102, for example represent two different disciplines and do not meet the default rule.

Students may not choose courses from either Computer Science or Software Engineering to count as related electives, but students are free to consider courses from all other disciplines. Students who follow the default rule do not file this form. The *Computer Science Undergraduate Advising Handbook* discusses related electives further and suggests possible uses.

This form is used for one of three purposes. If a student turns in this form more than once, the most recent form on file supersedes all preceding ones.

1. A student should file this form before taking any courses in Information Technology. In this case, check choice (1) in the student section and provide the requested information.

2. A student may file this form if they wish to propose twelve quarter hours of courses, offered by two or more disciplines, to be used to satisfy their related electives requirement. In this case, check choice (2) in the student section and provide the requested information.
3. A student who has previously filed this form and who wishes to void their previous selection should check choice (3) in the student section.
