

The chemical structure is a complex heterocyclic molecule. It features a central 1,2,4-triazine ring system. One nitrogen atom (N1) is part of a 5-membered ring fused to a 6-membered ring. The 5-membered ring contains a carbonyl group (C=O) and a hydroxyl group (OH). The 6-membered ring contains an amino group (NH2) and a carbonyl group (C=O). The 6-membered ring is further substituted with a 1,2,4-triazine-5-carboxamide group. The atoms are numbered from 1 to 25, with the numbering starting from the amino group and proceeding through the various rings and substituents.
